Why We Wear Green for Pentecost

Pentecost is called "Green Sunday." The insides of churches are covered with fresh branches of green trees. Green branches are also placed on the outside railings and doors of churches, and people also place a green branch on the door of their homes. Clergy and altar boys also wear green vestments, and many in the congregation wear something green. This custom comes from the fact that on Pentecost, 3000 people were baptized into the new faith. Green symbolizes new life, and Pentecost is thought to be the church's birthday. Green means life ... without the Holy Spirit, we are spiritually dead.

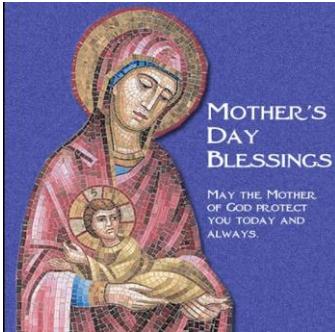

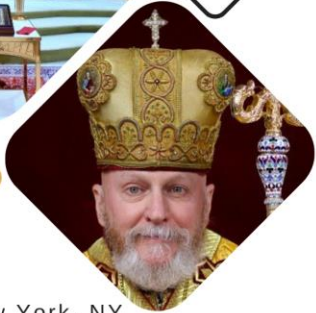

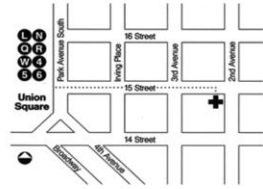
